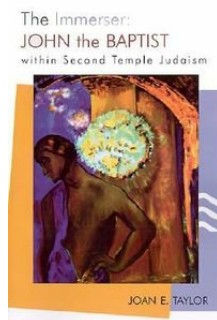


THE IMMERSER: JOHN THE BAPTIST WITHIN SECOND TEMPLE JUDAISM
