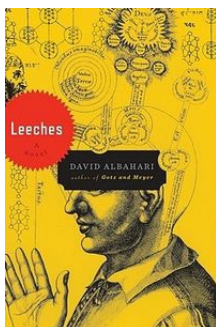


# LEECHES
