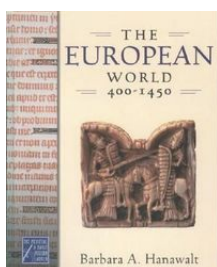


THE EUROPEAN WORLD 400-1450
